

English

English will cover the development and learning of: reading (phonics and comprehension); spelling; listening to stories and poems; speaking and listening; drama; handwriting; vocabulary, grammar and punctuation.

Autumn - Stories with familiar settings and repeating patterns, Non-fiction; labels, lists, signs and information texts. Poetry; performance, songs and repetitive poems, pattern and rhyme.

Spring – Fantasy stories about superheros. Non – fiction; instructions, information texts about toys. Poetry; humorous poems.

Summer - Traditional stories, Non-fiction; letters, Information texts about animals and plants. Poetry; poems about nature, traditional poems.

History

Autumn – Houses and homes; order events and objects in a sequence. Use key words “now”, “some time ago” and “a very long time ago”.

Spring – Compare toys today and from the past.

Summer – Holidays at the seaside today and in the past.

Art & DT

Autumn – Colour, observational drawings, collage (Mondrian). Making a home.

Spring – Exploring materials through collage. Painting plants (Van Gogh). An introduction to clay.

Summer – What is sculpture? Exploring seascape artists. Making a healthy lunch.

Mathematics

Autumn - Counting in 2's, 5's, 10's from and back to 0, understanding the operations of addition and subtraction and the related vocabulary, recognise 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p coins and equivalent values, Use everyday language to describe position and direction, Solve simple problems.

Spring – Counting and sequences to 100, Money - finding totals and finding change, Weight (kg and g) and time (o'clock, half past, quarter past/to), Doubling and halving, Place value, Capacity (l and ml) and measuring length (m and cm), Problem solving

Summer - Place value and fractions, addition and subtraction, 3D shape and time, Multiplication and division, Money, Time, position and direction.
