

### Science

**Plants.** The children will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.

They will find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

### Geography

We will learn about the continents and oceans of the world, and the countries of the United Kingdom using appropriate geographical vocabulary.

We will use aerial photos and plans to recognise landmarks, devise simple maps and construct basic symbols in a key.

### Art: The Seaside

We will look at the work of Anthony Gormley - Another Place as a stimulus for our work. We will use a range of materials creatively to design and make products

### Design Technology: Seed heads

The children will select and use a wide range of materials to investigate and make their own seed heads. They will evaluate their own work.

### English

Our topic this term will be Dragons. We will be looking at the text The Dragon Machine as a basis for writing our own story. The children will generate ideas and plan their own stories, ensuring they have an introduction, build-up, problem, resolution and ending. We will use descriptive phrases and similes to describe dragons, presenting our work as a poem.

We will look at apostrophes for possession and in contractions.

## Year 2: Summer 2019

### **Where in the world are we?**

### PE

This term we will be focusing on **Athletics** and **Tennis**. The children will master basic movements such as running, jumping, throwing and catching. They will be introduced to the basics of tennis and play small games.

### Music

We will learn songs related to the seaside, compose our own songs and play a variety of instruments with Mrs Ley.

### Mathematics

We will revise all the work taught so far in preparation for the SATs tests. We will be looking at investigations and problem solving involving the four operations. We will continue to focus on time to the nearest 15 minutes, and extend this to telling the time to 5 minute intervals. We will look at problems involving money, including making the same amount with different coins.

### ICT: Technology Beyond School and Online

**Safety:** Recognising common uses of IT beyond school, using technology safely and respectfully, and how to seek help and support.

### Safeguarding

Children will understand how to stay safe online, and what to do if they have concerns.

### RE

**Eastertide:** The children will know that Jesus has risen from the dead and still lives with us, and He will return again. They will know the story of the Holy Spirit. **The Church is Born:** the children will know that the apostles spread the good news when they received the Holy Spirit, and that God could work through them.
