English	Power of Reading Texts
<p>Through the Power of Reading books, the children will write both fiction and non-fiction pieces for a variety of audiences. Spelling, punctuation and grammar will focus on how to improve writing. Maths	RE
<p>Multiplication and Division: Children will learn to multiply 4 digits by 2 digits and how to divide 4 digits by 1 digit. Fractions: subtract 2 mixed numbers, multiply fractions and fractions of an amount. Decimals and Percentages: rounding, ordering and comparing decimals to 2 decimal places. Percentages as fractions and decimals.</p>	<p><u>Inspirational People</u> This topic will look at historical figures who lived by following the teachings of Jesus. <u>Reconciliation</u> In preparation for Lent the lessons will cover the topic of forgiveness and how actions can affect others. The importance of and an understanding of The Sacrament of Reconciliation and Confession will be discussed.</p>
Science	Humanities
<p>Earth and Space will be taught. Children will learn about our Solar System and the different planets it contains. They will learn about the movement of the Earth and the Moon and how this affects day and night.</p>	<p>Our Geography topic this term is South America. We will find similarities and differences between different places in South America and the United Kingdom. We will look at both the human and physical geography of South America including, trade, climates and land use.</p>
Computing	PE
<p>This term data is the focus. The children will learn how to enter data into Spreadsheets and then how to read from a Spreadsheet. Different databases will also be studied, looking at ways to present information effectively.</p>	<p>A new sport of Curling will be introduced. <p>Art lessons this term will focus on art movements from South America. The children will study different artists from South America and create portraits using these styles.
