KS1 Music	National Curriculum Requirements Pupils should be taught to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• use their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes• play tuned and untuned instruments musically• listen with concentration and understanding to a range of high-quality live and recorded music• experiment with, create, select and combine sounds using the inter-related dimensions of music.
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KS2 Music	Pupils should be taught to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ play and perform in solo and ensemble contexts, using their voices and playing musical instruments with increasing accuracy, fluency, control and expression▪ improvise and compose music for a range of purposes using the inter-related dimensions of music▪ listen with attention to detail and recall sounds with increasing aural memory▪ use and understand staff and other musical notations▪ appreciate and understand a wide range of high-quality live and recorded music drawn from different traditions and from great composers and musicians▪ develop an understanding of the history of music.
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
