<p><b>Addition and Subtraction</b> – adding by counting on, taking away by crossing, number bonds and related facts.  <b>Place Value</b> – numbers to 50, tens and ones, counting in 2s and 5s.  <b>Length and Height</b> – measuring length and comparing heights and lengths  <b>Weight and Volume</b> – measure mass and capacity.</p>	<p><b>Families &amp; Celebrations</b> – the children will reflect upon what it means to be a part of a family and learn about the celebrations that the Catholic Church partakes in.  <b>Following Jesus</b> – the children will learn about how Jesus chose some of his first disciples.</p>

<p><b>Materials</b> – the children will identify everyday materials and note their physical properties.  <b>The Seasons</b> – the children will observe changes across the four seasons and how day length varies.</p>	<p><b>History</b> – the children will explore the history of their local area.  <b>Geography</b> – the children will study the human and physical geography of their local area. They will compare the geography of their local area to Kenya.</p>

<p><b>Algorithms</b> – the children will understand that algorithms work by following precise instructions.
