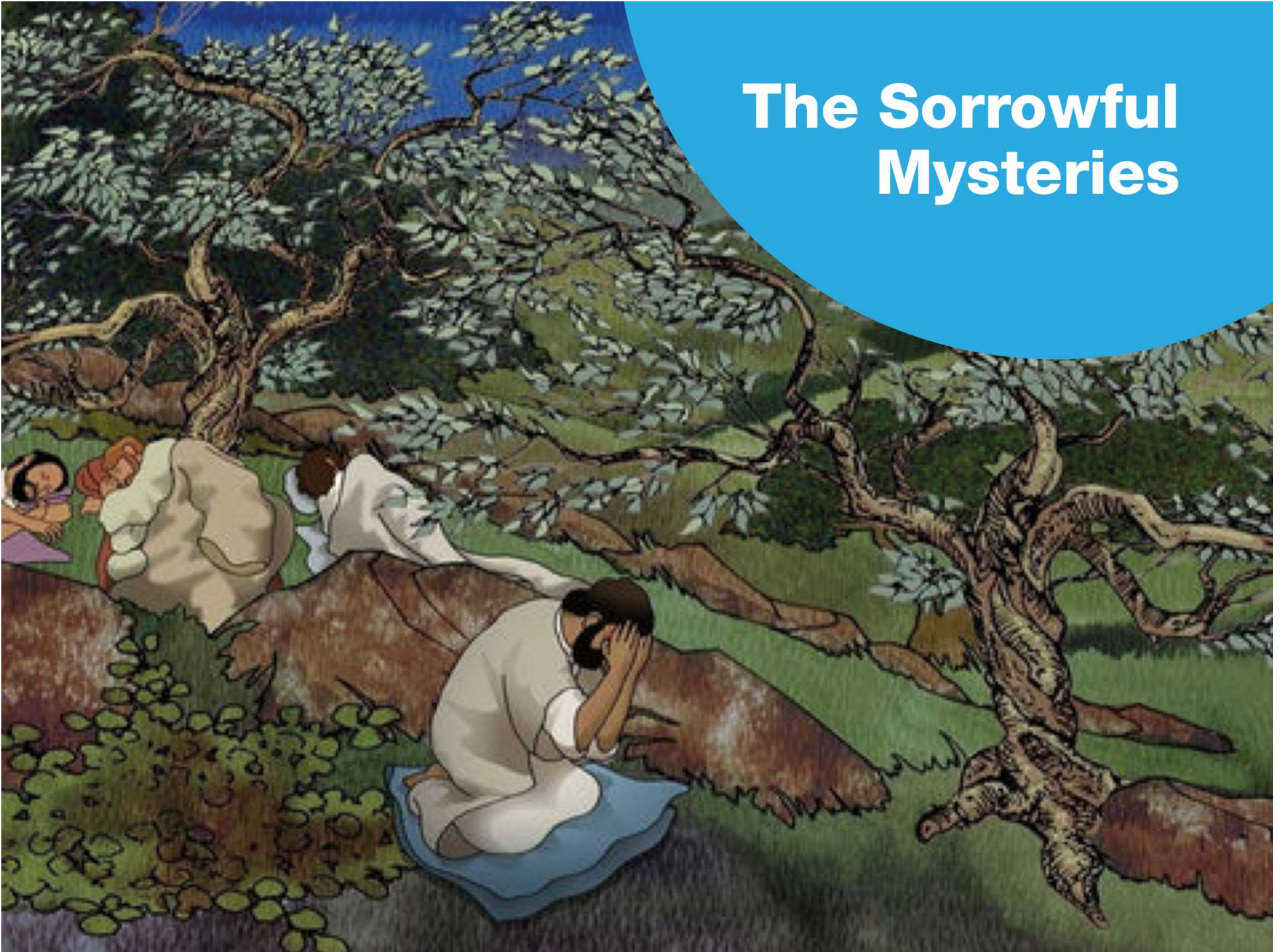

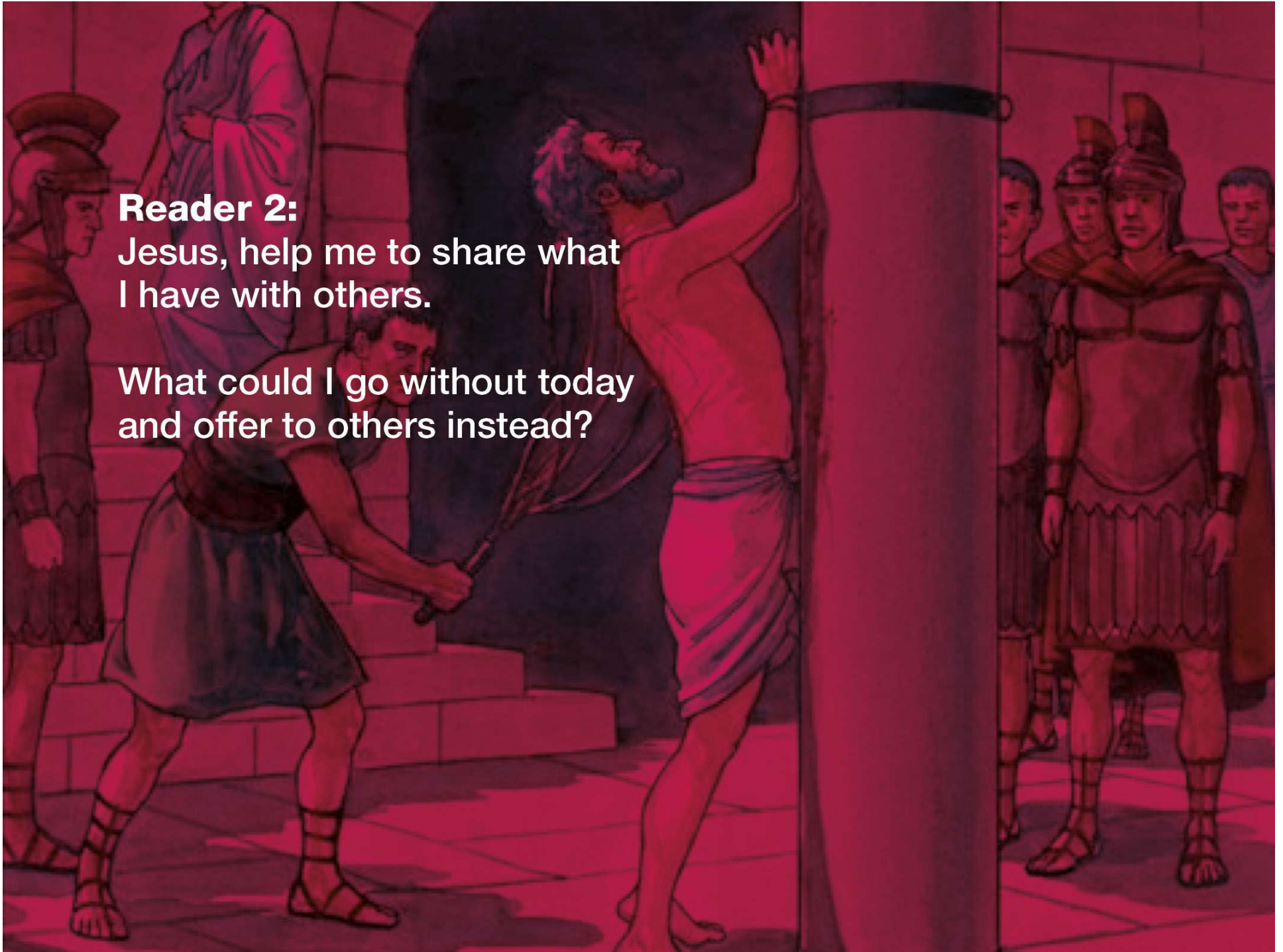
The second mystery is about Jesus' suffering when He was whipped by the Roman soldiers.

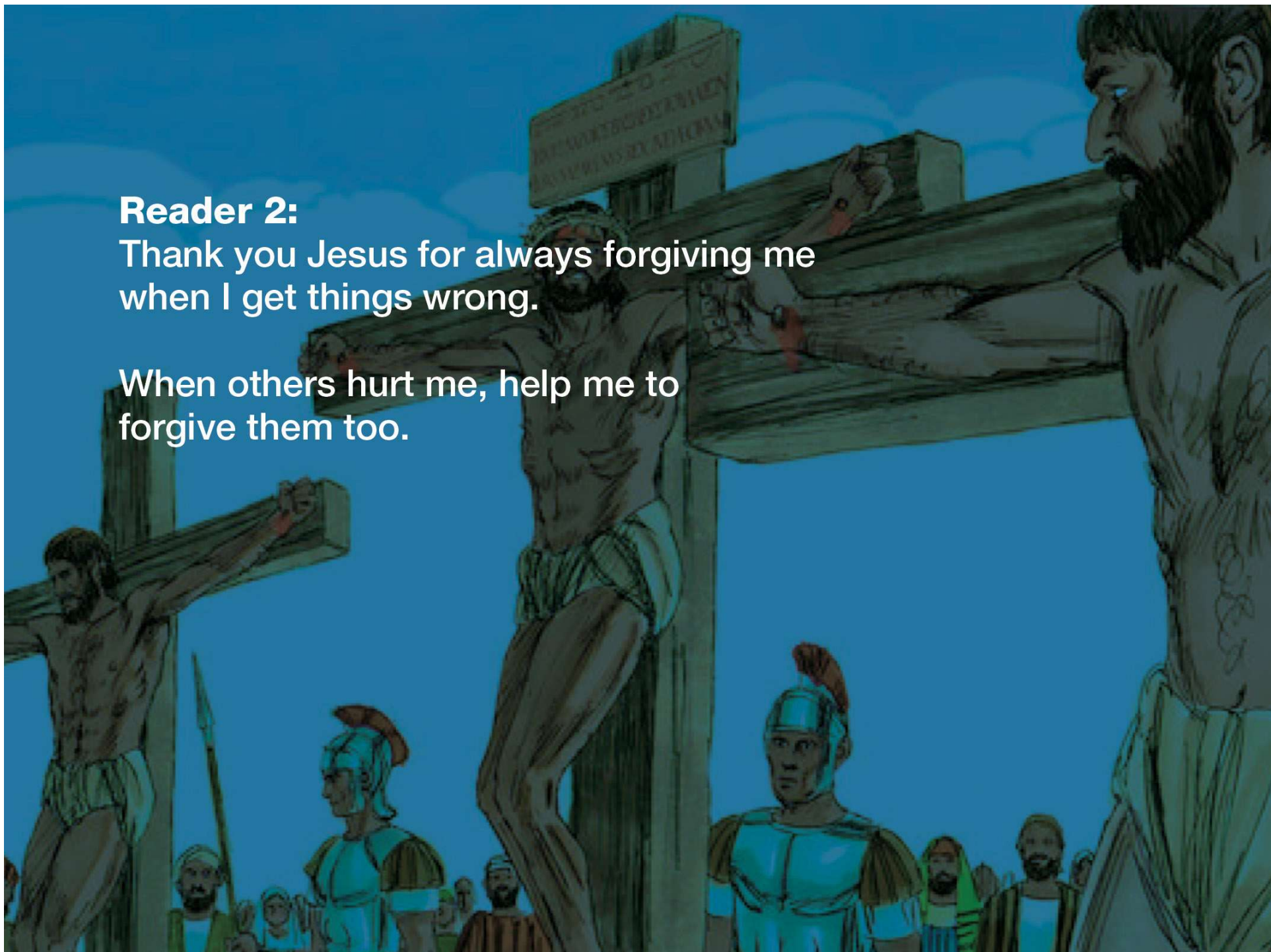
Reader 1:
