Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you have all had a lovely summer break. We are looking forward to welcoming the children back to School on Thursday this week. I would like to confirm a few points before the children return so that we are all ready to begin our new academic year.

The children in Years 1-6 will return on Thursday morning, Reception parents have been notified of the start date for their child. Gates on Culverley Road and Sangley Road will be open from 8:45am and School will start at 8:55am. Any child arriving after 8:55am will be marked as late on the register. Children will come into School, have their hands sanitised, and go straight to their classroom. In the School Hall at 8:45am we will have morning prayers and parents, carers and children who wish to attend are most welcome. Parents and carers attending are asked to wear a face covering and come in and leave via the external fire doors.

The school day will finish for all children in the main School at 3:15pm and children will be collected from their classroom door. Again we would ask parents and carers to wear a face covering. I would also ask parents to refrain from being on their mobile phone when on the School premises.

Parents and Carers will be aware that Culverley Road is a School Street and so you are unable to drive along it between 8:15 and 9:15 then again from 2:45 to 3:45 without incurring a fine. Please do walk or cycle to School if at all possible, if you need to drive then please do take care to park safely and legally to protect our children.

We look forward to children returning and looking smart in their uniforms. Please ensure that your child wears the full Holy Cross uniform including black school shoes, trainers are not allowed. With the weather being so unpredictable please also ensure that your child has a waterproof coat with them each day.
