autumn		In autumn, the weather begins to get colder. The leaves start to fall from the trees. The length of daylight becomes shorter. The daytimes are shorter and the night times are longer.	
winter		In winter , the weather is much colder. Sometimes it is cold enough to freeze, leaving frost and ice on the ground. It sometimes snows . Many trees have bare branches as all their leaves have fallen off. The day length is much shorter.	
spring		In spring , the weather starts to get warmer. The leaves begin to grow on the trees and some trees may blossom. Plants begin to grow and you may see baby animals around. The daylight becomes longer.	
summer	0° 0 0 0 0	In summer, the weather gets hotter. The daytime is long and the nights are short. Summer has the longest days. The trees are full of leaves and there are a lot of flowers, bees, butterflies and other insects.
